Besides the patriotic songs my favorite was "Moon River" which I remember singing in the high school choir.

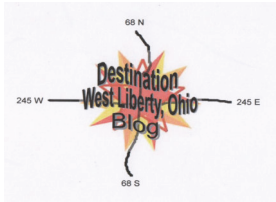
The Dairy Queen people gave out DQ gift certificates in a fun drawing and Micah Proudman helped director William Barrett pick the names.
